# What is a Medical emergency?!



Medical emergency means anything that can cause death or permanent harm

- Common Examples:
  - Trouble breathing
  - Strong pain to: Head, Abdomen, and Chest
  - Severe injuries (Example: work injuries, accidents, fights, crashes)
  - Loss OR change in consciousness
  - Non-stop bleeding (bleeding that does not stop with constant pressure after 10 minutes)
  - Blood in:
    - Cough
    - Vomit
    - Poop
